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The Mighty Ones — the most common Archangels



"The Mighty Ones" refer to the powerful archangels who are dedicated to assisting and supporting humanity in their spiritual growth and evolution, working tirelessly for the well-being and upliftment of individuals. The Mighty Ones are always focused on our welfare and unfoldment of our sacred selves throughout eternity. They are here to help us on our journey towards Ascension and to ensure that we are always supported and guided on our spiritual path (Council of Love)

The word Archangel comes from the Greek, meaning "chief angel," so these angels seem to be at the top of the angelic hierarchy (if there is such a hierarchy). There are seven Archangels mentioned in the non-canonical Book of Enoch, but since the Council of Rome of 382 CE chose not to include Enoch in the canon, they effectively removed these Archangels from the list of beings to be venerated. As a result, four of these seven archangels are not mentioned in most modern versions of the Bible.

Angels are neither feminine nor masculine, so any of the archangels may be depicted as either male or female, but tradition assigns one or the other to most. For instance, most Christians know the Archangel of Communication as Gabriel, but the Council of Love refers to her as Gabrielle. Feel free to imagine any of the archangels in whatever form is most comfortable for you.



Michael / Mikael

Archangel Michael is one of the most important of the archangels. His name means "Who is like God?", which is a reference to the battle between the fallen angels and the archangels. Lucifer (a.k.a. Satan) wanted to be like God; Michael was his antithesis.

In the Bible, Michael is the angel

general and the advocate for the people of Israel, the one who appears in Daniel's visions while in the lion's den, and the one who leads God's armies with a mighty sword against Satan in the Book of Revelation. He is said to be the patron saint of the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. In some occult religious sects, Michael is associated with Sunday and the Sun.

Michael is a powerful Archangel known for his qualities of peace, love, guidance, and joy in supporting and empowering individuals on their spiritual journey. He is a significant presence in the spiritual realm, offering guidance, protection, and support to humanity. Michael's energy is one of love, peace, and empowerment, helping individuals navigate their spiritual path and find strength in times of need. He is a beacon of light and a source of inspiration for those seeking guidance and protection on their journey towards spiritual growth and evolution.

Michael holds the distinction of being featured more often than any other named angel in major religious texts — the Torah, Bible, and Qur'an all mention Michael.

In the Torah, God chooses Michael to protect and defend Israel as a nation. Daniel 12:21 of the Torah describes Michael as "the great prince" who will protect God's people, even during the struggle between good and evil at the end of the world. In the Zohar (a foundational book in the Jewish Kabalistic mysticism), Michael escorts the souls of righteous people to heaven.

The Bible describes Michael in Revelation 12:7-12 leading armies of angels that battle Satan and his demons during the world's last conflict, for which Michael and his angelic troops finally emerge victorious. 1 Thessalonians 4:16 also mentions that Michael will accompany Jesus Christ when he returns to Earth.

The Qur'an warns in Al-Baqara 2:98: "Whoever is an enemy to God and his angels and his apostles, to Gabriel and Michael -- lo! God is an enemy to those who reject the faith." Muslims believe that God has assigned Michael to reward righteous people for the good they do during their earthly lifetimes.

Raphael



Archangel Raphael, whose name means "God heals" or "God's Healer," doesn't appear in the canonical Bible by name. Nonetheless, he is considered the Archangel of Healing, and as such, there may be a leftover reference to him in John 5:2–4, which mentions an angel of the Lord descending at certain times into the pool of Bethesda and moving the water, such that whoever went down first into the pond after the motion of the water was healed of whatever infirmity existed.

Raphael is the patron of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and connected to the planet Mercury and Tuesday.

Raphael is an Archangel known for his role as the Healer of the Universe and the Servant of the Mother. He is deeply connected to healing, rebirth, and restoring balance. Raphael's energy is associated with the emerald green ray, symbolizing healing and transformation. He works tirelessly to heal the hearts of humanity and to assist in restoring perfect balance on Earth. Raphael's presence brings comfort, healing, and renewal to those in need, guiding them towards wholeness and well-being.

Raphael appears in some Christian, Jewish, and Muslim texts. In the Catholic and Orthodox Christian traditions, the Book of Tobit, which is included in the Apocrypha, mentions Raphael among seven archangels. In the story featuring Raphael, he demonstrates his ability to heal different parts of people's health, including physical healing to restore the blind man Tobit's sight, as well as spiritual and emotional healing in driving away a demon of lust that had been tormenting a woman named Sarah. He then encourages Tobit and his son Tobias to sing praises to God, rather to him.

Raphael appears in the Book of Enoch, an ancient Jewish text, wherein God gives Raphael a healing assignment to restore the earth, as well as to "preside over every suffering and every affliction" of people on Earth. Similarly, in the Zohar, the Jewish Kabalistic text, Raphael "is appointed to heal the earth of its evil and affliction and the maladies of mankind."

In the Hadith, a collection of the Islamic prophet Muhammad's traditions, Raphael (who is called "Israfel" or "Israfil" in Arabic) is named as the angel who will blow a horn to announce that Judgment Day is coming. Also, Islamic tradition says that Raphael is a master of music who sings praises to God in heaven in more than 1,000 different languages.

Uriel



Archangel Uriel's name translates to "God is my light" or "Fire of God," and he is the Archangel of Repentance and of the Damned. He was the specific Watcher assigned to watch over Hades, the patron of the Sacrament of Confirmation. In the occult literature, he is connected to Venus and Wednesday.

Uriel is an Archangel who is known for being the bringer of the future and the anchor of the now. He is associated with the silver and ruby rays, embodying the qualities of fire, thunder, and storm. Uriel is a powerful presence who offers guidance, support, and illumination to individuals on their spiritual journey towards their highest potential. He is often referred to as the go-to angel for inspiration and for helping individuals recognize

their divine nature and capabilities. Uriel's energy is transformative and empowering, encouraging individuals to embrace their true selves and walk the path of truth and honesty, ultimately to embrace their divine nature and remember who they truly are

Uriel, sometimes known as Ariel, is not mentioned explicitly in the Bible, but some people have attributed Uriel to several recorded events, such as being the angel who guarded the Garden of Eden and the angel who slew the Assyrian army. However, the Book of Enoch (part of the Jewish and Christian Apocrypha) describes Uriel as one of seven archangels who preside over the world. It reveals that Uriel is the one who warns the prophet Noah about the upcoming flood and who reveals that the fallen angels who rebelled against God will be judged, showing Enoch a vision of where they are "bound until the infinite number of the days of their crimes be completed."

Similarly, another book in the Jewish and Christian Apocrypha, 2 Esdras, God sends Uriel to answer a series of questions that the prophet Ezra asks God. When answering Ezra's questions, Uriel tells him that God has permitted him to describe signs about good and evil at work in the world, but it will still be difficult for Ezra to understand from his limited human perspective (presenting him three impossible riddles to show how humans cannot fathom the ways of God).

In other Christian apocryphal gospels, Uriel rescues John the Baptist from being murdered by King Herod's order to massacre young boys around the time of Jesus Christ's birth and carries both John and his mother, Elizabeth, to join Jesus and his parents in Egypt. The Apocalypse of Peter describes Uriel as the angel of repentance. In Jewish tradition, Uriel is the one who checks the doors of homes throughout Egypt for lamb's blood (representing faithfulness to God) during Passover, when a deadly plague strikes first-born children as a judgment for sin but spares the children of faithful families.

Jophiel

Archangel Jophiel, Hebrew for "God is my beauty," generally meaning "Beauty of God," is associated with beauty, art, and wisdom.

Jophiel is a powerful and unique Archangel who plays a significant role in the spiritual realm. Jophiel is described as a magenta being who brings the future and is deeply connected to physicality. He is a builder in various aspects - etheric, spiritual, physical, mental, and emotional - embodying divinity and love.

Jophiel is also known for his association with Archangel Metatron and his role in anchoring Nova

Earth, holding a place of safety for all beings and creatures. Despite not being as frequently heard from, Jophiel works hand-in-hand with other divine beings to support humanity's spiritual growth and evolution, bringing order, divine structure, and transformation to individuals.

Jophiel is not mentioned by name in any Christian texts, but in Jewish and Kabalistic lore, (s)he is linked often with beauty and positivity. Jewish tradition also holds that Jophiel was the angel who guarded the Tree of Knowledge and cast Adam and Eve out of the Garden of Eden when they sinned and now guards the Tree of Life with a flaming sword. Jophiel is said to supervise the Torah's readings on Sabbath days.

In the Zohar, the sacred Kabalistic text, Jophiel is a great leader in heaven who directs 53 legions of angels. (S)he also is one of two archangels (the other being Zadkiel) who helps archangel Michael battle evil in the spiritual realm.

Jophiel is not listed as one of the seven archangels in the Book of Enoch, but is listed as one in the Pseudo-Dionysius's De Coelesti Hierarchia from the 5th century, which was influencial on Thomas Aquinas as he wrote about angels.

Jophiel appears in several other arcane texts, including the "Veritable Clavicles of Solomon," "Calendarium Naturale Magicum Perpetuum," early 17th-century grimoires or textbooks of magic, as well as the "Sixth and Seventh Books of Moses," another magical text from the 18th century purported to be lost books of the Bible that has spells and incantations.

John Milton includes Zophiel in the poem, "Paradise Lost," in 1667 as "of cherubim the swiftest wing." The work examines the fall of man and expulsion from the Garden of Eden.

Gabrielle / Gabriel

<u>Gabriel</u>'s name is translated variously as "the strength of God," "hero of God," or "God has shown himself mightily." (S)he is the holy messenger and the Archangel of Wisdom, Revelation, Prophecy, and Visions.

In the Bible, it is Gabriel who appeared to the priest Zacharias to tell him he would have a son called John the Baptist; and he appeared to the Virgin Mary to let her know that she would be soon giving birth to Jesus Christ. He is the patron of the Sacrament of Baptism, and occult sects connect Gabriel to Monday and the moon.

Archangel Gabrielle is a powerful being associated with Communications and Joy,

serving as the Central Administrator of the Universe. She is responsible for organizing and overseeing various responsibilities, ensuring that everything is in its rightful place. Gabrielle is a significant figure in the spiritual realm, known for her role in administering the Divine Plan and guiding humanity towards enlightenment and transformation. Her energy is one of love, communication, joy, organization, and empowerment, offering support and guidance to those on their spiritual journey.

The Bible does not give Gabriel the label of an archangel, but (s)he makes an appearance to Mary the Mother of Jesus, as well as Daniel, each time proclaiming news that will affect the future of the Israelite nation. In fact, Gabriel plays an important role in the religious texts of Islam, Judaism, and Christianity.

Christians, Jews, and Muslims all believe that Gabriel delivered news of the upcoming births of three famous religious figures: Isaac, John the Baptist, and Jesus Christ. Consequently, people sometimes associate Gabriel with childbirth, adoption, and raising children.

As mentioned previously, Christians believe Gabriel is the one who informing the Virgin Mary that God had chosen her to become the mother of Jesus Christ. During the same visit, Gabriel informs Mary of her cousin Elizabeth's pregnancy with John the Baptist. Christian tradition says that Gabriel will be the angel God chooses to blow a horn to wake the dead on Judgment Day.

Jewish tradition says that Gabriel instructs babies before they're born. In the Torah, Gabriel interprets the prophet Daniel's visions. Jews believe that, in heaven, Gabriel stands beside God's throne at God's left hand, sometimes charging Gabriel with expressing his judgment

against sinful people. For instance, Jewish beliefs says God sent Gabriel to use fire to destroy the ancient cities of Sodom and Gomorrah that were filled with wicked people. In Islam, the prophet Muhammad said Gabriel appeared to him to dictate the entire Qur'an. In the Hadith, Gabriel again appears to Muhammad and quizzes him about Islam's tenets. Muslims also believe that Gabriel gave the prophet Abraham a stone known as the Black Stone of Kaaba; Muslims who travel on pilgrimages to Mecca, Saudi Arabia, kiss that stone.

The Bahai faith says that Gabriel is one of God's manifestations sent to give people wisdom, like the prophet Bahá'u'lláh.

Metatron



Archangel Metatron is a powerful Archangel who plays a significant role in assisting humanity in their spiritual evolution and growth. Metatron is known for helping to shift humanity's consciousness and bringing beauty (in the form of bringing flowers to the heart of individuals) and fulfillment of divine promises to individuals on their spiritual journey. He is described as a bright angel of light, a communicator, and a keeper of promises during this time of magnificent change, whose energy is transformative and supportive, guiding individuals towards their highest potential and spiritual awakening.

According to the Zohar, the sacred Jewish Kabalistic book, the prophet Enoch was turned into the archangel Metatron in heaven and even describes him as "the king of angels" and says that he "rules over the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil." The Zohar reveals that God decided to allow Enoch to continue his earthly ministry forever in heaven by allowing him to continue working on a book that he started on Earth which contained "the inner secrets of wisdom" and then "was taken from this Earth to become a heavenly angel." God took him from this world so that he would serve Him above and "All the supernal secrets were delivered into his hands and he, in turn, delivered them to those who merited them."

The idea that God took the prophet Enoch is supported in the Jewish Torah and the Christian Bible by recounting that he lived an extraordinarily long life and then was taken up into heaven without dying: "All of Enoch's days were 365 years. Enoch walked with God, and was no more, because God had taken him."

The Jewish Talmud further mentions that God allows Metatron to sit down in his presence (which is unusual because others stand in God's presence to express their reverence for Him) because Metatron is constantly writing: " ... Metatron, to whom was given permission to sit down and write the merits of Israel."

Azrael



Archangel Azrael, Hebrew for "God has helped," is known as the Archangel of Transition, Change, and Grief. He is a compassionate and loving presence who assists individuals in navigating the process of transition, especially during times of loss and grief. Azrael helps souls transition from the physical realm to the spiritual realm with love, comfort, and support and, as such, is a comforting presence for those who are experiencing the loss of a loved one, helping them find peace and solace during difficult times.

Many have labeled Azrael as the Angel of Death in the tenth plague in Egypt, although Scripture never mentions an explicit name of that angel. In fact, Islamic tradition says that Azrael is the angel of death, since the Qur'an refers to him by his role "Malak al-Maut," which literally means "angel of death," rather than by his name. The Qur'an describes that the angel of death doesn't know when it's time for each person to die until God reveals that information to him, and at God's command, the angel of death separates the soul from the body and returns it to God.

Azrael also serves as the angel of death in Sikhism. In Sikh scriptures, God sends Azrael only to people who are unfaithful and unrepentant for their sins, where he appears on Earth in human form and hits the sinful people on the head with his scythe to kill them and extract their souls from their bodies. Then he takes their souls to hell and makes sure that they get the punishment that God decrees once he judges them.

However, the Zohar, the sacred Jewish Kabalistic book, presents a more pleasant depiction of Azrael. The Zohar says that Azrael receives the prayers of faithful people when they reach heaven and also commands legions of heavenly angels.

Chamuel



Archangel Chamuel, which means "One who seeks God," is known as the angel of peaceful relationships. Other spellings of his name include Camiel and Samael.

Chamuel is an Archangel known for his role in bringing peace, love, and comfort to individuals, who is often called upon to help people find inner peace, resolve conflicts, and strengthen relationships. Chamuel's energy is gentle yet powerful, offering support and guidance in matters of the heart and relationships. He assists in opening the heart chakra, promoting self-love and compassion, and bringing harmony and love to

those in need.

People sometimes ask for Chamuel's help to: discover more about God's unconditional love, find inner peace, resolve conflicts with others, forgive people who have hurt or offended them, find and nurture romantic love, and reach out to serve people in turmoil who need help to find peace.

Chamuel isn't mentioned by name in major religious texts, but in both Jewish and Christian tradition, he has been identified as the angel who carried out some key missions, including comforting Adam and Eve after God sent Archangel Jophiel to expel them from the Garden of Eden as well as comforting Jesus Christ in the Garden of Gethsemane before Jesus' arrest and crucifixion.

Gi'anna / Gaia

Archangel Gi'anna (meaning "anna or angel of Gaia") is a celestial being who has taken on the form of planet Earth, embodying it as a "petri dish for love." Gi'Anna is described as the Archangel of Beauty, Strength, and Service, working tirelessly for the rebirth of love on Earth, just like her sister Archangel Gabrielle. Gi'Anna's presence and essence are deeply intertwined with the healing and restoration of Earth, harmonizing with all beings to awaken the union of heart, soul, and purpose.

Archangel Gi'Anna is associated with the

radiant, emerald green color, symbolizing healing, restoration, and harmony, reflecting the energy of Archangel Raphael, who is known as the healer of the planet and humanity. The emerald green color is also linked to Gaia, the Earth, along with the Mother's blue, which is the ray that many beings such as animals, plants, fairies, elementals, and devas travel upon. By connecting with the green ray, one can feel the interconnectedness with all kingdoms on Earth.

Archangel Gi'Anna offers the gift of embodying planet Earth as a petri dish for love, providing the opportunity for healing, restoration, and harmonization with all beings on Earth through her presence and essence, as well as a deep sense of interconnectedness and unity among all living beings.

Buddha

The Buddha identifies himself as the Wayfarer.

Buddha, however, is a title, meaning "One Who is Awake." His name was Siddhartha Gautama, and he lived in northern India c. 563 - 483 BCE as a Hindu prince who renounced his position and wealth to seek enlightenment as a spiritual ascetic. After years of study, contemplation, and frustration, he attained his goal and ultimately founded Buddhism in India in the 6th - 5th centuries BCE.

He became known as the Buddha because he achieved enlightenment while meditating under "The Bodhi Tree" in Bodh Gaya, when he realized that the path to peace of

mind was through mental discipline to walk the Middle Way (i.e. the point of balance and nonduality). Buddha was not a god, but he was (is) one free from illusions.

The main teachings of Buddhism are in the "Four Noble Truths." The First Truth states that life is "dukkha," which means suffering or unable to satisfy. The Second Truth tells us that dukkha has a cause, and that cause is craving, which is as a result of not understanding reality and not fully under-standing and knowing ourselves. The Third Truth states that we can know the cause of dukkha and be liberated from life's stresses and cravings. The Fourth Truth tells us that insight comes through the practice of the Noble Eightfold Path.

The Eight-Fold Path is an outline of eight areas of practice that include living a responsible and ethical life that benefits others, meditation, and mindfulness, among others.



Djwhal Kuhl


Master of the Second Ray of Divine Love and Wisdom, possessing a vast knowledge of the rays and planetary hierarchy of the solar system. He is humble enough to often identify himself simply as "DK."

Djwhal Khul is an excellent master teacher, focusing on how our conscious minds evolve and offering us a safe transition to the spiritual while on earth.

He gathers wisdom from various spiritual traditions and makes the truths available to us through interesting stories. In this way, he is very engaging, delightful, and

humorous, while provoking one's thoughts with his views on the affairs of the world and addressing the deepest questions that people have. He guides his students through problems they are facing and encourages them to stay on course in their spiritual paths.

Djwhal Khul is an incarnation of the same soul who incarnated as Lao Tzu. (See Lao Tzu entry.) In other lifetimes, Djwhal Khul is purported to have been Caspar, one of the Three Wise Men / Zoroastrian Magi to visit the newborn Yeshua/Jesus (the one who gave gold, representing the body).



El Morya


Chohan (Master) of the First Ray and chief of the Darjeeling (India) Council of the Great White Brotherhood. He is also referred to as the Defender of Faith and Keeper of the Scepter (of Divine Authority). His ray is pale blue.

El Morya represents the godly attributes of courage, certainty, power, forthrightness, self-reliance, dependability, faith and initiative. These are the qualities of the Father principle—the statesman, the executive, the ruler.

He inspires followers to wear the crown of divine authority, and inspires leaders to rule wisely, holding to the tenet that government should be God-over-men and the concept of the true statesmen is to be God's overmen. He inspires in his subjects illumined obedience to the holy will of God. In fact, he often advocates aligning one's will to do good and to that of the Divine Will.

In other incarnations, El Morya purportedly embodied as:

- 1. Abraham, the first Hebrew patriarch;
- 2. Melchior, one of the Three Wise Men / Zoroastrian Magi to visit the newborn Yeshua/ Jesus (the one who gave myrrh, representing the soul);
- 3. King Arthur, guru of the mystery school at Camelot;
- 4. Thomas Becket, Archbishop of Canterbury;
- 5. St. Sergius, founder of over 40 monasteries in Russia and one of the Russian Orthodox Church's most highly venerated saints;
- 6. Sir Thomas More, the "man for all seasons";
- 7. Akbar the Great, founder of the Mogul empire in India and the greatest of its rulers; and
- 8. Thomas Moore, the Irish poet laureate.



Jesus Sananda (Yeshua)

Christed Master, Messiah, Master of the Sixth Ray, member of the Great White Brotherhood, World Teacher, and Founder of Christianity. While he is known most prevalently today as Jesus, this is actually a Greek derivative that first appeared in 1632! His given name in Aramaic was Y'shua/Yeshua, which converts to Jeshua or Joshua in Hebrew. His Higher Self is known as Sananda, so he most often identifies himself as Jesus Sananda, or simply brother Yeshua or Yeshi.

The story of Jesus/Yeshua is well-documented in the Christian Bible, but other sources have filled in missing accounts that show his teachings are universal¹. For instance, during the so-called missing years between the ages of 12-30, he studied in preparation for his role and ministry, first with Judy, an Essene prophetess and leader (regarding the prophesies of the Messiah), then with Junner in Persia (regarding the unified teachings of Zend), then in India with Kahjian (regarding cleansing the body for physical and mental strength), and finally in Egypt with Zar (regarding the basis of Temple service and what results from crucifying self for an ideal).

Jesus Sananda's ray is magenta, and his focus is as the World Teacher on unconditional love (Christ Consciousness), forgiveness and compassion (Love your neighbor as yourself [Matt 22:39]), and alignment and devotion to the will of God.


In other incarnations, Jesus Sananda purportedly embodied as²:

- 1. Adam, the first Man;
- 2. Enoch, patriarch and author of the non-canonical Book of Enoch;
- 3. Melchizedek, king of Salem and high priest of the God Most High;
- 4. Joseph, son of Jacob (with the "coat of many colors", 17th-16th century BCE);
- 5. Zend, father of Zoroaster and inspiration behind Zend-Avesta, 15th century? BCE);
- 6. Joshua, Hebrew military leader of Moses (13th century BCE);
- 7. Prophet Elisha (9th century BCE); and
- 8. Jeshua, high priest upon return from Babylon (6th century BCE)

Kuthumi



Chohan (Master) of the Second Ray of Wisdom and Divine Love, which governs all truth and understanding in the world. He belongs to the Brotherhood of the Golden Robe (i.e. those who take on the burdens of the world), working to transform religious beliefs into those of unconditional love. His titles include, Keeper of the Golden Flame/Ray, Bringer of the Future - Anchor of the Past, Keeper of the Door / Portal / Gateway, the I AM of the Eastern Christed Consciousness, World Teacher, and Lord of Compassion.

Lord Kuthumi is a Master Psychologist, sharing the teachings of the Golden Age of Psychology. He is among those who take on the pain of the world, clarifying


the mysteries of the universe that seem to make humankind curious. He comes to those who seek knowledge of the things that cannot be fully explained by logic. He overlights professionals, artists, and other workers to ensure that the work leads to the growth and development of humankind by imparting wisdom, understanding, truth, and knowledge into others.

He is the Doorkeeper of the ancient occult mysteries and is co-protector with Archangel Michael of the holy grail, which is the mystical quest of self understanding and mastery. The six pointed star of David is his symbol, bringing perfect balance of mind, body and relationships.

According to Theosophists, Kuthumi was a contemporary and friend of El Morya.

He has appeared in Zahara, Egypt, and Tibet, among others, having purportedly embodied as:

- 1. Egyptian Pharaoh Thutmose III (Menkheperre, 1479-1425 BCE), the grandfather of Amenhotep III (see Serapis Bey);
- 2. Egyptian Pharaoh Ramesses II (Usermaatresetepenre, 1279-1213 BCE);
- 3. Pythagoras, the great Greek Initiate;
- 4. Balthazar, one of the Three Wise Men / Zoroastrian Magi to visit the newborn Yeshua/ Jesus (the one who gave frankincense, representing the mind);
- 5. Saint John the Beloved, the one closest to Master Jesus;
- 6. Saint Francis of Assisi (1182-1226 AD);
- 7. Saint Martin de Porres (Lima, Peru 1579-1639 AD);
- 8. Shah Jahan, builder of The Taj Mahal in India; and
- 9. Kuthumi Lal Singh, Indian Kashmiri Prince (19th Century AD).



Lao Tzu

Chinese philosopher; author of Tao Te Ching and founder of Taoism. Lao Tzu (variously spelled Laozi, LaoZi, Lao Tse, Lao Tze) is actually a Chinese honorific, generally translated as "the Old Master". Through COL channelings, he has also referred to himself as the Ancient One, the Keeper/Master of LaHoChi, Master and Teacher of Balance, and Teacher of the Middle Way. He, himself, says he goes beyond being a philosopher — he is also a teacher and healer.

Traditional accounts say his given name was Li Er, born in the state of Chu in the 6th century BCE and served as

the royal archivist for Emperor Zhou's court as the Royal Archivist. He was likely a contemporary of Confucius, as there is one account when he met and impressed Confucius. Ultimately, he composed the Tao Te Ching, the foundation of Taoism, before retiring into the western wilderness.

Lao Tzu is known for and generally associated with the Blessing & Virtue of Humility, and his ray is magenta. Along with Saint Germain, he brought forth and teaches the COL 13th Octave LaHoChi energy balancing and healing methodology, which he learned during an incarnation in Atlantis from Pleaiedian visitors.

In other lives, he embodied as Djwhal Khul in Tibet. (See Djwhal Khul entry.)



Maitreya

Chohan (Master) of the Sixth Ray of Enlightenment, Ascension, Devotion, and Idealism, although he combines the energies of the 2nd and 6th Rays. He is the head of the Great White Brotherhood and is known as the Liberator and the Master of Masters. Other titles include Bringer of the Future - Bringer of the Now; Horseman of the East - Brother of the West; and Buddha of Love, of the Future, of the Now, of One, of All.

He has said, "I am honored to be known as the Buddha of Love, or as Krishna, or as Imam, but I am equally honored to be known simply as brother. I am bringer of truth, of wisdom and love. That is what I teach, that is what I am, that is what I do."

Maitreya means "Universal Love." In the Orient, his name means "Lord of Love," whereas other people refer to as the Master of Hope and the Loving One, with Buddhists associating him with kindness. His main focus, though, is on promoting universal love and spiritual enlightenment.

It is believed that Lord Maitreya serves in the function of the role of "Energizer of the Earth" and "Controller of the Solar System." His work is to ensure that the Earth is in good shape at all times and that humankind does not destroy it through their activities.

In other lives, he is believed to have been Krishna, as well as Hotei, known as the Laughing Buddha.



Mary Magdalene

As told in the Bible, Mary was the (younger) sister of Lazarus and Martha, who first met Jesus when she was taken to be stoned for being "taken in adultery" with Romans³, but she was forgiven by Jesus and ultimately cleansed of her sins. (Mark 16:9 says she was the one "out of whom [Jesus] had driven seven demons."). The Gospels relate that she was present at the Crucifixion, was the first to see Jesus after his resurrection, and was present at his Ascension. Edgar Cayce also relates that she became very close to John (the Beloved) following the Resurrection and Ascension since Mother Mary lived with him near Bethany. He also said she lived 22 years after Jesus' death and Ascension.⁴

According to the COL, Mary Magdalene (often referred to as the Magdalena) was a student of the Mystery Schools and had received extensive training as a channeler and as a Keeper of Sacred Ritual/Rites, including from the Essenes and Eastern traditions. She is the Initiatrix of the Temple. Of particular note, Mary was married (i.e. united is Sacred Union) to Yeshua (Jesus), and they had two children, Samuel Thomas James and Sarah. Samuel died when he was three, but Sarah lived for many years, ultimately moving with Mary to a place of safety after Yeshua's Ascension.⁵ Many believe this place of safety was Southern France, in particular Saint Mary Magdalene's Cave in La Grotte de Sainte-Baume in Provence, not far from Marseille.

Mary Magdalene is associated with the Divine Feminine, especially as it relates to restoring the balance between the Divine Feminine and the Divine Masculine. She also often speaks of embracing one's physicality and enjoying ALL one's senses.

She and Yeshua also served together as off-world beings as the Egyptian Isis and Osiris.

Quan Yin



Master of the Third Ray of unconditional love and member of the Karmic Board of the planet, carrying the titles of the Goddess of Compassion, the Goddess/ Bodhisattva of Mercy, and the Goddess of Determination. Quan Yin means "Hearer of Sounds" because before entering heaven, she stood at the edge and heard humankind crying. She chose to forego entry and liberation in the higher realms to come back to help to those who are suffering or struggling.

She helps those who are fighting internal and external

battles in their lives, and she is a great healer and also works with healers to bring wellness to the emotional body. Her divine qualities are mercy, forgiveness, and compassion.

In meditation, Quan Yin will often appear in the form of the swan or the lotus, and she is often depicted as sitting on a lotus. But in the context of the COL, she is most often seen riding a Chinese dragon.

Sanat Kumara




As the Universal Logos (formerly the Planetary Logos), he is the head of the Spiritual Hierarchy of Earth, overseeing the Ascension of the planet (which he has done for millions of years). He is known by various titles, including The Initiator, The Fountainhead of the Will, Youth of Endless Summers, the Lord of the World, and even The Ancient of Days in the Bible. In his role as Logos, Sanat Kumara is also the Keeper of the (13) Universal Laws.

He is regarded as one of the seven Holy Kumaras (the sons who remained pure) of Brahma in Hinduism. In Sanskrit, the name means "Eternal Youth."

According to legend, Sanat Kumara came to earth from Venus at a time when humanity had sunk so low that the Solar Logos was about to dissolve planet Earth. He voluntarily came to redeem this planet. The Cosmic Council had decreed the dissolution of Earth and her evolutions because her children no longer worshiped the Trinity in the trifold flame of life burning in their heart. Sanat Kumara made a plea for and on behalf of Earth to the Council of the One Hundred and Forty and Four. After considerable deliberation, the Cosmic Council and the Nameless One gave their approval of his petition, and a new divine plan for Earth came into being.

The aura of ascended master Sanat Kumara is clear like ice, such that all colors flash through it. His twin flame is whom we know as Venus.



Serapis Bey

Chohan (Master) of the Fourth Ray of Purity, Hierarch (Chief Priest) and Keeper of the Ascension Chamber at Luxor, and the thirteenth member of the Council of Adepts of the Ascension Temple. The fourth ray is the Ascension Flame (or White Fire Ray, White Flame of Purity, the Ray of White Crystalline Essence of the Mother) centered in the Root chakra.

Known as the Great Disciplinarian, he rekindles the sacred fire in the hearts of a mankind. He promotes iron will, discipline, and determination to reclaim man as kings and priests unto God, and he assists his students in the self disciplines of the four lower bodies that are necessary for ascension.

His focus is architecture, the principles of mathematics, the foundations of the building of the Matter temple and the pyramid of Self. He supports architects, planners and those dedicated to the purity and discipline of any undertaking.

Serapis Bey came from Venus with the Ancient of Days (Sanat Kumara) and was a high priest in the Ascension Temple on Atlantis. In Egypt, he was the architect of the Great Pyramid when embodied as the Egyptian Pharaoh Amenhotep III. At Luxor, he initiated the ascending ones in the applications of the sacred fire, architect of holy orders, the inner life, and golden-age cities, military disciplinarian of the forces of Light, Peace, and Cosmic Freedom.

In other incarnations, Serapis Bey purportedly embodied as:

- 1. Leonidas, the Spartan king; and
- 2. Phidias, the Athenian sculptor during the 5th century BCE, who was the architect and construction supervisor of the Parthenon.



Saint Germaine

Master and Keeper of the Violet Flame, Chohan (Master) of the Seventh Ray, Hierarch of the Aquarian Age, and sponsor of the United States of America, purportedly present at the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Another title and function is Keeper/ Custodian of the I AM Presence.


He is a master alchemist who comes bearing the gift of the Violet Flame of freedom for world transmutation. Interestingly, he asked Linda Dillon in a channeling to include the final "e" in his name to emphasize the reanchoring of the Divine Feminine.

Saint Germaine initiates our souls in the science and ritual of transmutation through the Violet Flame, the ray of freedom, justice, mercy, alchemy and sacred ritual—a new lifewave, a new civilization, a new energy. He attracts diplomats, priests of the sacred fire, actors, writers and defenders of freedom to transmute personal and planetary past errors in thought, feeling and action.

He was high priest of the Violet Flame Temple on Atlantis 13,000 years ago, but he is known as Saint Germaine, which comes from the Latin Sanctus Germanus meaning "Holy Brother," because he physically appeared throughout the courts of 17th and 18th Century Europe as Le Comte de Saint Germaine.

In other lifetimes, he purportedly embodied as:

- 1. The prophet Samuel;
- 2. Saint Joseph;
- 3. Saint Alban, the first martyr of Britain;
- 4. Merlin, alchemist, prophet and counselor to King Arthur;
- 5. Roger Bacon;
- 6. Christopher Columbus; and
- 7. Sir Francis Bacon.



Wa'kana'taka

The Primary Representative of Earth to the Intergalactic Council, as well as the one who tends to those who tend the Council Fire of Gaia. He is a very ancient being who, as the head of the rapidly expanding Earth delegation, sits at the intergalactic table and then brings forth the messages from the Council to guide the Earth in her ascension and helping her human people through their own awakening. In that role, he is part of the governance of Earth.

Although not the same, *Wakan Tanka* is the Lakota term for the sacred or the divine, which is usually translated as the "Great Spirit" and occasionally as "Great

Mystery". Wakan Tanka can be interpreted as the power or the sacredness that resides in everything and, thus, is similar to the supreme beings found in the myths of many other North American peoples. Perhaps Wakan Tanka was inspired by a memory of Wa'kana'taka.
